Students in both programs will follow a defined sequence of coursework and are required to attend an annual in-person meeting each year to remain active in the Ph.D. program. More details can be found on the LT Ph.D. website or in the LT Ph.D. Doctoral Student Handbook.






In addition to a faculty advisor who students will select during the annual meeting, each student in the program is also assigned an Associate Graduate Faculty (AGF) mentor.

AGFs are professionals (i.e. terminal degree with academic experience) in the field who oversee the student's work toward his or her dissertation. An AGF's role during course work is to actively engage and speak with the student throughout course work in order to 1) ensure the student is doing well academically, 2) keep the student focused and successful regarding short term outcomes, 3) position the student for success at later stages (portfolio, dissertation proposal, dissertation), and 4) provide additional communications back to the program concerning student progress and retention.

Department staff will reach out to your first choice to see if they are eligible to serve in the role. If yes, the AGF mentor will reach out to you directly. After communicating, if they agree to endorse your application, a letter will be placed with your application packet for faculty review. If you are admitted to the program, your AGF mentor will be cc'd on your welcome email to assist getting you settled into the program.
